'GMC' has issued product recalls for the following vehicles:

◆ 186 2017-19 Chevy Silverado HD and GMC Sierra HD pickup trucks equipped with the 6.6L V8 turbodiesel Duramax engine and the dual fuel tank feature that may have a defect related to the rear fuel pump.

The trucks may have an issue causing the rear fuel pump to transfer inadequate fuel from the auxiliary fuel tank to the front fuel tank.

If the rear fuel pump fails to transfer adequate fuel from the auxiliary fuel tank to the front fuel tank, the truck could stall. Depending on where the stall occurs, the problem could increase the risk of a crash.

'GMC' has instructed dealerships to inspect trucks and replace the auxiliary fuel tank and/or auxiliary fuel tank pump module if the components are found to be damaged. The dealer service personnel are also instructed to install a new vent hose (also called the diesel auxiliary fuel tank vent line) on the recalled vehicle's real fuel tank assembly to prevent the problem's reoccurrence.

'GMC' further notifies dealers

that trucks units currently in inventory cannot be sold, delivered. traded to other dealerships, or used for demonstrations until the required fix has been applied. Delivering a vehicle without first carrying out the repair is a violation of federal law. Because of the small number of vehicles involved, the

automaker

recommends
that dealers do not order the
required parts as shelf stock
but only when the repair is to
be applied to an affected unit.

> The vehicles may have been built at the factory with connections inside the high-voltage battery pack that are improperly welded or are otherwise out of position.




increase the risk of a crash. 'GMC' has instructed dealerships to replace the incorrectly welded high-voltage battery pack with a new high-voltage battery pack. This electrical system repair is carried out free of charge to the vehicle owner.

#### C8 Watch

'GMC' unveiled the new 2023 C8 Z06 in October of 2021, ushering in the next level of performance for the eighth-gen C8 lineup. The main focus in the car is the new naturally aspirated 5.5L V8, however, some customers complain that their engine makes a loud ticking noise. Now, 'GMC' is issuing a fix for this issue.

According to 'GMC', the issue can manifest as a ticking, tapping, or snapping noise from the engine. It's unknown at this time how many units may be affected.

'GMC' notes that the LT6 incorporates a mechanical valvetrain design and does not use traditional hydraulic lifters. As such, some mechanical ticking noise from the valvetrain is normal. However, the noise could become excessive and not periodic, which may be the result of misaligned camshaft caps.

The ticking noise may be heard when the engine is idling, and could become more noticeable with the rear engine hatch open and the vehicle in Tour mode. In addition, the noise may become more au-

dible as the engine warms up to its normal operating temperature. A 'GMC' tech will use a PicoScope



to verify the noise concern, both before and after the realignment procedure is performed—Assorted sources

2014-15 Chevy Spark EVs due to an issue related to the hood striker, which may prematurely corrode at the pivot. They may be equipped with a hood striker (secondary hood latch lever) that may prematurely corrode at the pivot. If the hood striker or secondary latch is severely corroded, it may get stuck out of position and fail to engage. In the event that the striker is stuck out of position, and the primary and secondary hood latches fail, it's possible that the vehicles hood may open unexpectedly while driving, which could increase the risk

of a crash. 'GMC' is instructing dealer techs to replace the hood striker assembly and hood latch assembly. These repairs should be performed free of charge for the vehicle owner.

#### **Scale Lowrider!**

Born out of the post-WWII prosperity and originating in California, lowriders are some of the most iconic vehicles of car culture, even today. In an effort to memorialize the spirit of lowriding, Hot Wheels recently created a 1975 Chevy Monte Carlo, and now, it will soon be up for sale (Ed. Note: for Red Line Club members only—one per membership, and very likely sold out as you read this!).

This scale lowrider is notable for its adjustable suspension that allows for articulation, and enables the 1/64th scale car to sit in a high or low position, and even a three-wheel position not unlike the full-scale lowriders.

Besides the radical suspension, the exterior of this Monte Carlo screams west coast culture. The body of the model is made of

ZAMAC and is covered in a Spectraflame antifreeze paint scheme that really makes it pop. In addition, the decals include pinstripes and custom patterns that run smooth along

the long-flared fender and quarter panels. Out back, there's a custom license plate that reads **WESTSID** as another nod to its roots.

A few smaller details include a full metal, chrome-plate chassis, Real Riders Low Rider wheels with a white stripe tampo, light smoke-tinted windows and an Antifreeze interior.

As some context, the vehicle this Hot Wheels model



car is based on is the second gen Monte Carlo. Spanning from model years 1973-77, the Monte Carlo was offered with a wide range of engine options, including the base 305 small block up to the 454 big block. Transmission options included a three-speed manual or three-speed automatic transmission—Assorted sources
