
MAMA will be notified as to the progress of the Memorial.

* Ford F-150 Lightning (AMT #6153): Molded in Lt. Gray....reissue of F-150 short wheelbase truck....incorrect XLT moldings on sides of truck body....correct front bumper w/air dam, twin-tube rear bumper....new Lightning intake....incorrect chrome grille (should be body color)....new bucket seats....Firestone tires.
* 1994 Mustang GT (AMT #6178): Molded in Lt. Gray....separate front, rear bumpers (w/nice indented 'MUSTANG' lettering)....tail lights done correctly....chrome headlight buckets....disc brakes at all wheels, quad-shock rear suspension....nicely engraved 5.0 intake...platform interior w/separate side panels...very fine dash engraving....chrome 3-spoke mags mounting incorrect Goodyear ZR tires (as compared to GS-C's).


